Job Description			

The Sterile Compounding Technician is responsible for compounding prescription medications and stock medications in the sterile compounding laboratory at SaveWay Compounding Pharmacy, a Myonex Company (SWCP) following formulas generated in pharmacy software. The Sterile Compounding Technician is responsible for establishing and maintaining a controlled working environment.

Duties:

- Assist the pharmacist in providing timely, efficient, and appropriate pharmaceutical care to the patient.
- Preparation and sterilization of CSPs using aseptic technique and following processes in full compliance with USP Chapters <797> and <800> in a timely manner.
- Processing prescriptions in computer utilizing compounding software.
- Must possess a working knowledge of USP Chapters <795>, <797> and <800>.
- Must be familiar with other USP Chapters pertaining to compounding both sterile and non-sterile preparations such as USP Chapters <51>, <71> and <85>, <1160>, <1168> and <1176>.
- Check medication storage areas for out-of-date products and preparations.
- Order, receive, and restock components and supplies to meet daily demands of the sterile lab.
- Establish and maintain the ISO Class environment while performing manipulations. Maintain an orderly working environment.
- Perform daily, weekly, monthly cleaning duties as outlined in facility SOPs.
- Receive calls from other departments answering questions in a courteous and professional manner, referring to the pharmacist where appropriate and as needed.
- Ensure that all medications are stored properly, checking BUDs and EXP dates.
- Prepare medication orders for delivery and/or shipping in a timely manner meeting established deadlines.
- Use PPE and/or closed system transfer devices (CSTDs) appropriately to protect CSPs from contamination and to protect personnel and the environment from exposure.
- Follow appropriate procedures for gowning and garbing. Maintain proper personal hygiene for work in the cleanroom environment as outlined in facility SOPs.
- Successfully complete all competencies and maintain aseptic technique and other skillsets required by department policy.
- Restock supplies used throughout the work shift.
- Add chemicals or other supplies to be reordered in the ordering tab on TEAMS.
- Processing prescriptions and generating a prescription label using pharmacy software.
- Orient and train new pharmacy personnel in a welcoming, friendly, and professional manner.
- Recommend ideas to the supervisor for improvement of methods and procedures.
- Perform other duties as required or assigned for emergencies or other operational reasons for which the employee is qualified to perform to maintain an appropriate level of pharmacy service.
- Maintain a current knowledge of all departmental policies and procedures.
- Complete mandatory education and assigned competencies.



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- Perform assigned work safely adhering to established departmental rules and practices. Report to supervisor in a timely manner and an unsafe activities, conditions, hazards, or safety violations that may cause injury to oneself, colleagues, customers, or visitors.
- Maintain a safe work environment and exhibit safe work practices.
- Pursing personal development of skills and knowledge necessary for the effective performance of the role. Willing to attend training to further develop relevant knowledge, technique, and skills.
- Perform other related duties as required.
- You must have flexibility to work outside normal work hours, as required.

- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- Professional appearance
- Mobility within the entire facility
- Able to prove US employment eligibility
- Able to pass drug screening
- Able to pass background screening
- Flexibility to work overtime/weekends, as required

• Must not make a non-budgeted, emergency expenditure, or commitment of SWCP.

Confidentiality/Conduct

- Must not divulge any confidential patient or protected health information (PHI).
- Will not engage in gossip or other unprofessional conduct.
- Must comply with HIPAA's privacy and security requirements.
- Will not share any of SWCP's proprietary information.

Appearance

- Must maintain a professional appearance. Attire must be neat and clean. Good hygiene is mandatory.
- Must wear facility-specific scrubs and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) per facility SOPs while in the sterile compounding lab. Additional PPE is required for handling hazardous drug substances. Due to the mobile nature of the position, clothes and shoes should be comfortable.
